

Strangulation Identification Training

Strangulation injury is a risk for survivors of violence.

This training will provide participants with the knowledge and understanding of strangulation in domestic violence and sexual assault including: the mechanism of injury, the signs and symptoms of strangulation, identifying and assessing victims, the short and long-term health implications of strangulation, consent and erotic asphyxiation, and documenting and advocating for the victim.

On completion of this workshop the participants will have a good understanding of strangulation and the process of identification, assessment, and care of strangulation victims.
